Heavyweight champ Parker hits the road to boost profile

MANCHESTER, England (AP) — Fresh from getting his chest waxed and boasting a slick new haircut, heavyweight champion Joseph Parker arrived in a tailored two-piece suit for a final news conference before the second defense of his WBO belt.

The New Zealander certainly looks the part outside the ring going into Saturday's fight against Hughie Fury in Manchester.

What is still unknown is how he shapes up inside it.

In a bid to strengthen his "brand" and gain exposure in the boxing world, the 25-year-old Parker is hitting the road after fighting in his native country for 12 of his last 13 bouts.

Britain is his first stop. The plan is to beat Fury, the 23-year-old cousin of former world heavyweight champion Tyson Fury, to improve his record to 24-0 and potentially set up a showdown with WBA and IBF champion Anthony Joshua.

"I feel like the UK is where the heavyweight scene is at, at the moment," Parker said on Thursday at Old Trafford, home of storied soccer team Manchester United. "We want to be a part of it. We feel it's important to come here and make a statement."

Question marks remain over New Zealand's first heavyweight champion, though. His trainer, Kevin Barry, acknowl-



Monthly Fuel Surcharge Notification

The American Samoa Power Authority is informing its customers about the monthly fuel surcharge rate, which is the direct cost of fuel to generate electricity. The charge for each kilowatt hour (kWh) comprises the "base rate" and the "fuel surcharge rate."

The base rate, which remains the same monthly for all electric customer classes, pays for ASPA's operating costs and for infrastructure upgrades needed to get power to your home and business.

The fuel surcharge rate changes monthly due to fluctuating fuel costs. The fuel surcharge is approximately 70%-75% of the total kWh price. This is considered a "pass-through" revenue because it goes directly to pay the local fuel suppliers for diesel fuel consumed at the five power plants in Tutuila, Manua and Aunu'u.

The fuel surcharge rate also includes the "Renewable Reduction" from electricity produced by the ASPA Photo Voltaic panels. The avoided fuel costs or fuel being saved from producing electricity through the Photo Voltaic panels, is passed on to customers as the "Renewable

Reduction" savings. There are six active sites, with more sites in progress to increase ASPA's renewable energy portfolio. As ASPA increases renewable energy capacity, more savings will be realized and passed on to customers.



**Finally humbled, Cowboys' Prescott, Elliott look to respond**

FRISCO, Texas (AP) — Dak Prescott didn't need long to answer whether Dallas' 42-17 loss to Denver was his most humbling day in the NFL.

Larry Fitzgerald, Arizona's 10-time Pro Bowl receiver, didn't have much sympathy for Prescott's "probably so" in reference to the first blowout loss for last year's NFL Offensive Rookie of the Year and fellow first-year star Ezekiel Elliott, the league rushing champion.

"I would say they're damn lucky," Fitzgerald said. "It took them 18 regular-season games to be humbled. I got my humble pie Week 2 of my rookie year — a big, big dose of it. Then it happened a few more times my rookie season."

Well, now it's happened to Prescott and Elliott, which gives them a chance to show how they'll respond in a second straight road game when the Cowboys visit Fitzgerald and the Cardinals on Monday night.

Prescott threw two interceptions in a game for just the second time, on the same day he became the first NFL quarterback with 500 attempts and fewer than five interceptions. The first led to a 35-10 Denver lead, the second was returned 103 yards for the punctuating touchdown.

The interceptions ended up reflecting poorly on Elliott as well because he didn't pursue Chris Harris Jr. on the first interception and repeated the mistake on Aqib Talib's long return.

Hall of Fame running back

LaDainian Tomlinson accused him of quitting, and coach Jason Garrett didn't do much to dispel the notion. Nearly lost in the hubbub: by far a career-worst game with 8 yards on nine carries.

"I definitely heard it," Elliott said. "I would say I was just very frustrated, but that's no excuse for the lack of effort I showed on tape. I just can't do that. Being one of the leaders on the team and being a guy that people count on, I can't put that type of stuff on film."

Prescott took equal ownership in the locker room Thursday, saying the coaches adjusted and gave the Cowboys chances to recover from a miserable start, only to be undone by his poor execution.

It wasn't Prescott's worst game statistically. That came last season in a 10-7 loss to the New York Giants. But the perception then was the Cowboys were due for such a showing because they had won a franchise-record 11 straight games with two rookies leading the offense.

The dominating showing by the elite Denver defense came a week after the Cowboys methodically handled the Giants in the opener. Now Prescott has to show how quickly he can get the Cowboys back to that form.

"It's important for me to be the same," Prescott said. "Come in with the same energy, the same leadership, get these guys going. Maybe be contagious to not lose confidence or even be worried. It's Week 2 in the

NFL. We have a lot of football left to play."

Center Travis Frederick easily remembered his most humbling NFL game: at Chicago his rookie year in 2013. He studied one of Julius Peppers' moves countless times and was sure he was ready for it until Peppers changed directions and "sent me flying 6 yards into the backfield" on a sack.

"Told myself to trust my technique at that point," Frederick said. "Don't ever try to outsmart the game because the game will outsmart you at all times." Frederick just happened to recall the previous time the Cowboys gave up at least 40 points in a game: a 45-28 loss to the Bears that started a season-ending skid of three losses in four games.

Prescott and Elliott faced bounce-back games only twice as rookies, winning both with fourth-quarter rallies. In the second victory at home against Tampa Bay, Prescott had a career-best completion rate (89 percent) and Elliott had his highest rushing total (159 yards). But last season, they were never bouncing back from blowouts and the midweek chatter that comes with such games.

"We don't go out there and play for the talking heads," said Elliott, who is playing because of an injunction that stopped his six-game suspension over a domestic incident while the case plays out in court. "We go out there to have each other's back. So that's our motivation."

California hits Gatorade in court for "anti-water" videogame

SACRAMENTO, Calif. (AP) — Gatorade has agreed not to make disparaging comments about water as part of a \$300,000 settlement reached Thursday with California over allegations it misleadingly portrayed water's benefits in a cellphone game where users refuel Olympic runner Usain Bolt.

The game, downloaded 30,000 times in California and 2.3 million times worldwide, is no longer available.

The dispute between the sports-drink company and California Attorney General Xavier Becerra was settled in less than a day after Becerra filed a complaint in Los Angeles County.

Becerra's complaint alleges the game, called Bolt!, misleadingly portrayed the health benefits of water in a way that could harm children's nutritional choices. The game encour-

aged users to "keep your performance level high and avoid water," with Bolt's fuel level going down after drinking water but up after drinking Gatorade, the complaint alleged.

The settlement should serve as a warning to companies that falsely advertise, Becerra said.

"Making misleading statements is a violation of California law. But making misleading statements aimed at our children is beyond unlawful, it's morally wrong and a betrayal of trust," he said in a statement.

Gatorade agreed to the settlement but has not admitted wrongdoing.

"The mobile game, Bolt!, was designed to highlight the unique role and benefits of sports drinks in supporting athletic performance. We recognize the role water plays in overall health and wellness,

and offer our consumers great options," spokeswoman Katie Vidaillet said in an email.

In addition to agreeing not to disparage water, Gatorade agreed not to make Bolt! or any other games that give the impression that water will hinder athletic performance or that athletes only consume Gatorade and do not drink water. Gatorade also agreed to use "reasonable efforts" to abide by parent company PepsiCo's policy on responsible advertising to children and to disclose its contracts with endorsers.

Of the settlement money, \$120,000 will go toward the study or promotion of childhood and teenager nutrition and the consumption of water.

The game was available in 2012 and 2013 and for a limited time in 2017.

edged that Parker was not at his best in his last two fights — the victory on points over Andy Ruiz Jr. that earned him the WBO strap and then an underwhelming first successful defense of the belt against Razvan Cojanu, also on points, in May.

He dreams of becoming as well-known as the All Blacks rugby team but he still has a low profile outside New Zealand and the WBO belt is still regarded as the flimsiest of the heavyweight titles. The fight against Fury is even going under the radar in Britain, with only 5,000 tickets sold for the 21,000-capacity Manchester Arena. YouTube — rather than a TV broadcaster — is showing it.

It's time for Parker to send a message to the rest of the heavyweight division.

"We know the size of this challenge," Barry said. "We have an opportunity, here in our first fight in the UK, to look spectacular."

Given Fury has a reputation for being as unpredictable and awkward to fight as his more illustrious cousin, that won't be easy. Not only that, Fury hasn't fought in around 18 months while he battled to overcome an energy-sapping skin condition that has affected him throughout his professional career. Fury, who is unbeaten in

20 fights, says he is feeling "100 percent" for the first time as a boxer, so neither fighter really knows what to expect.

The fight is also being staged in Fury's home city, after the original fight — scheduled to take place in Auckland in May — was canceled owing to a back injury sustained by Fury.

"He is a very difficult opponent," Barry said. "He is an opponent a lot of people don't want to fight. We sat down as a team and said to Joe, 'Do you want to fight Hughie Fury?' And he said, 'I want to fight the best fight there is for me in the UK at the moment.'

"We have planned on coming here for the past 12-to-18 months. We think Hughie brings the biggest challenge to us."

The build-up has been light on trash talk, with Parker living up to his image of being clean-cut and courteous.

"I know it's the wrong sport for a good guy, but everyone is his friend," Parker's mother, Sala, told The Associated Press. "Joe has no enemy in the entire world. His opponents are his best friends."

Still, Parker said there were doubts over Fury's power and his chin, and he felt he saw "fear in his eyes" as they went face to face for the cameras.

"He took a big gulp," Parker said. "I thought, 'He's scared.'"

AS-EPA beach advisories inform the public about current water conditions.

When a beach advisory is issued, it is because water samples indicate that the American Samoa Water Quality Standard for Enterococci has been exceeded. This advisory is in effect until further sampling and laboratory analyses indicate that Enterococci concentrations are within acceptable water quality standards.

The presence of Enterococci in the water indicates contamination by human and/or animal wastes. Swimming in water with high levels of Enterococci may cause stomach problems, skin rashes, and ear, eye, and wound infections. To reduce your risk: avoid swallowing beach water, be sure to rinse or towel off after a swim, and shower once at home. If you are ill, or think you may be ill, AS-EPA advises that you consult a physician before making any water contact in the beaches cited above.

Note: AS-EPA monitors the water quality of 44 recreational beaches on Tutuila, the wharf in Aunu'u, and five beaches on Manu'a. Tutuila advisories are issued weekly on Wednesdays. Aunu'u and Manu'a advisories are issued monthly. Advisories are issued when bacteria concentrations exceed levels determined safe for human exposure. Gareth Barry: Record-breaker, great Premier League survivor

Arsene Wenger was days away from winning the Premier League for the first time as Arsenal manager. Michael Owen was English soccer's latest player of the season. The original Ronaldo had a couple of months left as the world's most expensive player.

It was May 2, 1998, and in a fairly non-descript occasion at Hillsborough, Gareth Barry — a 17-year-old defender with floppy dark hair and already a cultured left foot — came on as a 49th-minute substitute for Aston Villa in its 3-1 win over Sheffield Wednesday.

A remarkable, if understated, career was born.

More than 19 years later, Barry is still playing in England's top division and, on Monday, will break the Premier League appearance record if selected by West Bromwich Albion for its away match at Arsenal.

It will be Barry's 633rd appearance in the most-watched league in the world, surpassing the record he held with Manchester United great Ryan Giggs. Of his tally of 632, Barry has started 600 of them. It is a testament to his longevity, adaptability and quality that he has lasted so long in the fast-paced, blood-and-thunder world of English soccer.

"I didn't think I'd get here," Barry said on Thursday ahead of his potentially record-breaking game. "When I hit 500, you're thinking you're coming to the end of your career. I've been able to keep going."

Barry played 365 league games for Villa, 132 league games for Manchester City, 131 league games for Everton and has featured in four league games for West Brom. Having started out as a center back equally comfortable at left back, he is now an out-and-out

holding midfielder — perhaps the best position on a soccer field for someone his age, as it involves a player using his head as much as his legs.

Barry credits his longevity to avoiding serious injury and to support from some now-retired former teammates.

"No one has said, 'What are you doing still playing?'" the 36-year-old Barry said. "Everyone said, 'Play as long as possible.' You stop when you stop enjoying it and I'll know when I've had enough and can't keep up with the boys."

That's still not the case for Barry. Only last year, he was being hailed as "one of the best English players ever" by his then-coach at Everton, Roberto Martinez, who is admittedly prone to hyperbole, after a man-of-the-match performance against Man City in the League Cup semifinals.

He was a much-cherished member of City's Premier League title-winning team in 2011-12, shoring up the midfield to allow Yaya Toure to rampage forward. He had turned down a move to Liverpool to join City.

Barry has slotted seamlessly into his new surroundings at West Brom, where he has replaced another veteran midfielder in Darren Fletcher.

"They're bastions of this sport," West Brom manager Tony Pulis said. "The young players at our football club, I hope they realize how lucky they are to see someone of that quality and that ilk."

Barry has worn the captain's armband for England on several occasions among his 53 caps for his country. Globally, however, the most vivid image of Barry in an England jersey was in 2010 when he trailed in the wake of Mesut Ozil in the build-up to Germany's final goal in its 4-1 win in the round of 16 at the

World Cup.

"I've not set any targets, and taken it a season at a time," Barry said. "It's a fantastic life I've been living — let's keep it going. I want to go as long as possible."

Outside of the Premier League era that started in 1992, goalkeeper Peter Shilton holds the appearance record for England's top flight with 849 games. Former Chelsea defender/midfielder John Hollins has made more outfield appearances in the topflight than any other player, with 714.

Here's what else to watch out for in the sixth round of Premier League games:

PALACE'S PROBLEMS

Crystal Palace is in last place after failing to win a point or score a goal in its first five matches. Even more concerning is that the team's fixtures are about to get much tougher.

A visit to league leader Manchester City is next up on Saturday, before games against the other members of the current top four — Manchester United, Chelsea and Newcastle.

No wonder new Palace manager Roy Hodgson is envisaging an "even worse scenario" for his team in a few weeks.

REMATCH

After a winless run of four games across three competitions, the pressure is starting to ratchet up on Liverpool manager Juergen Klopp.

And it's showing. Klopp said he was "sick" of Liverpool conceding sloppy goals after its 2-0 loss at Leicester in the League Cup on Tuesday. Four days later, the teams meet again at King Power Stadium in the league. Leicester has beaten Liverpool at home in the past two seasons, with Liverpool's defense failing to deal with the pace and movement of Jamie Vardy on both occasions.

Aaron Hernandez had severe CTE; daughter sues NFL, Pats

BOSTON (AP) — Former New England Patriots star Aaron Hernandez had a severe case of the degenerative brain disease chronic traumatic encephalopathy, researchers said on Thursday. His lawyer announced a lawsuit against the NFL and the team for hiding the true dangers of the sport.

Dr. Ann McKee, the director of the CTE Center at Boston University, said Hernandez had Stage 3 (out of 4) of the disease, which can cause violent mood swings, depression and other cognitive disorders.

"We're told it was the most severe case they had ever seen for someone of Aaron's age," attorney Jose Baez said.

Hernandez killed himself in April in the prison cell where he was serving a life-without-parole sentence for murder. Baez said Hernandez had shown signs of memory loss, impulsivity and aggression that could be attributed to CTE.

"When hindsight is 20-20, you look back and there are things you might have noticed," he said.

But you don't know."

CTE, which can only be diagnosed in an autopsy, has been found in former members of the military, football players and boxers and others who have been subjected to repeated head trauma.

A recent study found signs

of the disease in 110 of 111 NFL players whose brains were inspected.

The lawsuit filed in U.S. District Court claimed that the league and Patriots failed to protect their players' safety, leading to the disease that deprived Hernandez's 4-year-old daughter, Avielle, of her father's companionship.

"Defendants were fully aware of the dangers of exposing NFL players, such as Aaron, to repeated traumatic head impacts," the lawsuit said. "Yet, defendants concealed and misrepresented the risks of repeated traumatic head impacts."

NFL spokesman Brian McCarthy said the league had not yet seen the lawsuit and could not comment.

A Patriots spokesman did not immediately respond to a message seeking comment.

The league recently agreed to pay \$1 billion to retired players who claimed it misled them about the dangers of playing football.

The "loss of consortium" lawsuit filed on Thursday is independent of the class-action suit that began making payments this summer. Baez said it was the first of its kind.

"If we have to be ground-breakers in this area, it's something we're prepared to do," he said.







DEAR ABBY: My husband and I usually hosted all the get-togethers among our friends. We haven't been able to do that for about six months.




