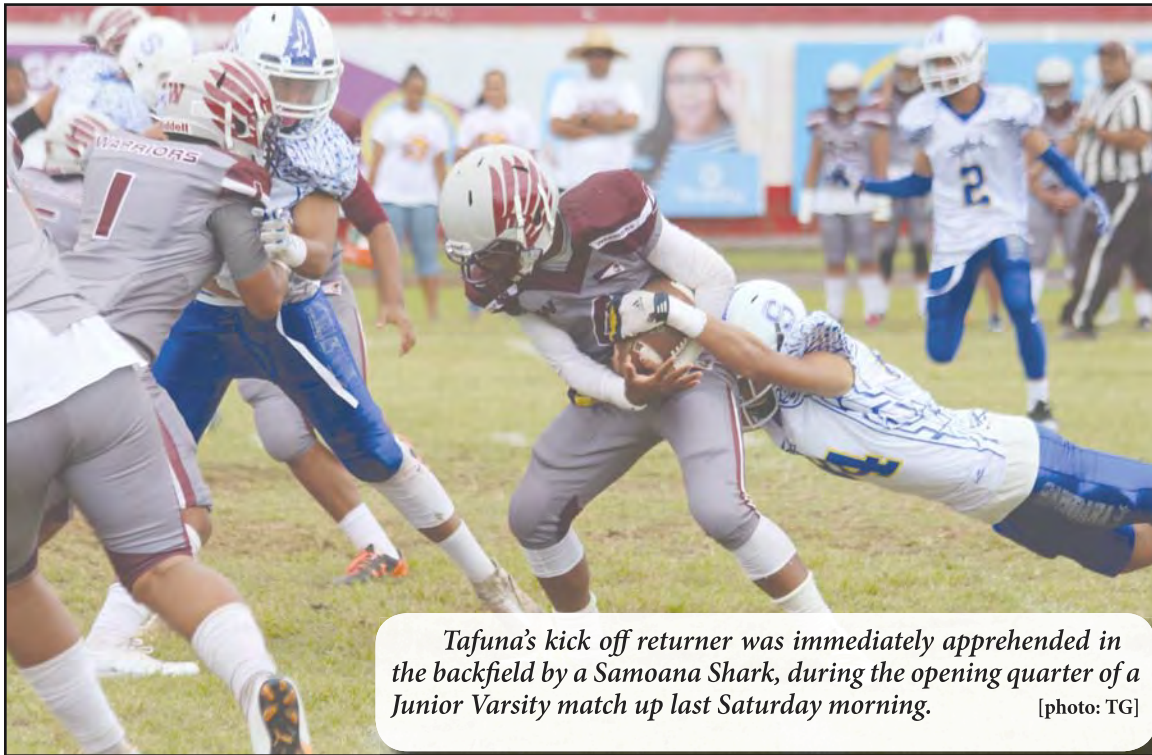

# Warriors defense stop the Sharks in astounding 48-21 victory

TAFUNA IS NOW THE ONLY UNDEFEATED TEAM IN VARSITY COMPETITION 3-0-0

Last Saturday, the American Samoa High School Athletics Association (ASHSAA) kicked off week 3 of high school football at the Veterans Memorial Stadium – fielding one of the long awaited battles between the Sharks and the Warriors, where Tafuna's defensive coordinator Kevin Magalei and the Warriors defense, destroyed Samoana's offense in a 48-21 victory in the varsity division.

Coverage of the 2017- 18 ASHSAA football season is sponsored by Congresswoman Aumua Amata.

However, in the junior varsity division game between Samoana and Tafuna, the Sharks just dominated the Warriors with their 'air-attack' – led by offensive coordinator Keith

Samoa News would like to point out that Samoana High School's first win this season was disqualified by ASHSAA, after the team failed to turn in their physical testing (PT) documents from the Department of Health, an annual procedure that all teams have to go through before the season.

### Varsity Division Warriors 48, Sharks 21

Upon receiving the opening kick-off of the game, Tafuna opened up the match by shooting themselves in the foot with penalties. The Sharks didn't have to lift a finger in the Warriors 20-yard loss that opened the game. Shortly, after head coach Kolose Ili regrouped his team in a time out, Tafuna returned firing, as Tala Sufia sent Fetu

Gaoa up the middle for the opening touchdown of the game. A two-point conversion to Panapa Filoiali'i was stopped immediately in the backfield by Solomona Seiuli of the Sharks, but nonetheless Tafuna took the early six-point lead.

3:42 still in the first quarter, and Tafuna's second down on Samoana's 30-yard line, and Sufia hooks up with Pene Fa'avae again – in the air this time on a 30-yard pass attempt that scored six more points for the Warriors.

To open up the second quarter, Tafuna's passing game escalated dangerously for Samoana's defense, as they could barely keep up with the Warriors' option game – utilizing a balanced attack of Run-N-Gun strategy that opened another opportunity to the end zone.

Warriors' first down inside Samoana's red zone, and Sufia on a quarterback keeper managed to punch one in for six.

After a whole quarter of being tortured by Elton Titania and Tafuna's defensive front, Samoana finally solved the mystery on how to overcome Tafuna's defensive pressure. After a long run from David Mikaele, setting up the Sharks inside the Warriors' 10-yard line, Anthony Feala fired a laser to Zephaniah Pati for their first touchdown of the game.

The field goal conversion by Elliot Lelei was good enough to bring them back to life and trail the Warriors 7-18 with just 8:32 remaining in the opening half of the game. Then, with just 24 seconds remaining in the

## Banged-up Packers beat winless Bengals 27-24 in overtime

GREEN BAY, Wis. (AP) — Aaron Rodgers looked around the locker room before Green Bay’s game against the Cincinnati Bengals and noticed all the Packers starters sidelined with injuries. Defensive lineman Mike Daniels, receiver Randall Cobb and left tackle David Bakhtiari, just to name a few.

“But we’ve had a rallying cry at the beginning of the season,” Rodgers said. “No excuses.”

And no way were the Packers going to lose Sunday after Rodgers figured out the Bengals defense.

He threw for three touchdowns and 313 yards, including a 72-yard pass to Geronimo Allison to set up the winning field goal in the Packers’ 27-24 victory in overtime over the winless Bengals (0-3).

Reliable veteran Mason Crosby kicked the 27-yarder with 6:26 left in overtime after Allison’s big gain came on a free play for Green Bay (2-1).

Defensive end Michael Johnson was whistled for off-side on third-and-10 from the Packers 21. Officials let the play continue and Rodgers found Allison on a throw that sailed about 43 yards before the receiver beat a couple defenders to get inside the 10.

Rodgers also connected with Jordy Nelson for a 3-yard touchdown pass with 17 seconds left in regulation to tie the game at 24, completing a 12-play, 75-yard drive. Cornerback Dre Kilpatrick narrowly missed batting away the bullet thrown by the quarterback into the front right corner of the end zone.

“Far too many chunk plays

against a good quarterback like that. That ended up being the difference in the football game,” Bengals coach Marvin Lewis said.

A two-time NFL MVP, Rodgers added a couple more bullet points to his extensive resume.

—He has now beaten all 32 teams in his 13-year NFL career, the last 10 as a starter.

—He won his first game in overtime. One play that he’d like to forget: Cornerback William Jackson returned an interception 75 yards for a touchdown and a 21-7 lead early in the second quarter for Cincinnati. It was just the second career interception returned for a touchdown for Rodgers, and his first at Lambeau Field.

“A lot of time, a lot of time left. We’ve been down before,” said Rodgers, who finished 28 of 42. Other notes and take-aways from Sunday’s game:

**BENGALS OFFENSE:** At least Cincinnati’s offense finally got into the end zone. Receiver A.J. Green’s 10-yard touchdown catch on the game’s first possession snapped a season-opening streak of 25 possessions without a touchdown. Until Sunday, they were only able to muster three field goals over the first two weeks.

**LAZOR SHOT:** Quarterback Andy Dalton was 21 of 27 for 212 yards and two scores in a game that featured Bill Lazor’s debut as Bengals offensive coordinator. Lazor replaced the fired Ken Zampese. The Packers, though, made some adjustments after halftime and got to Dalton with more pressure.

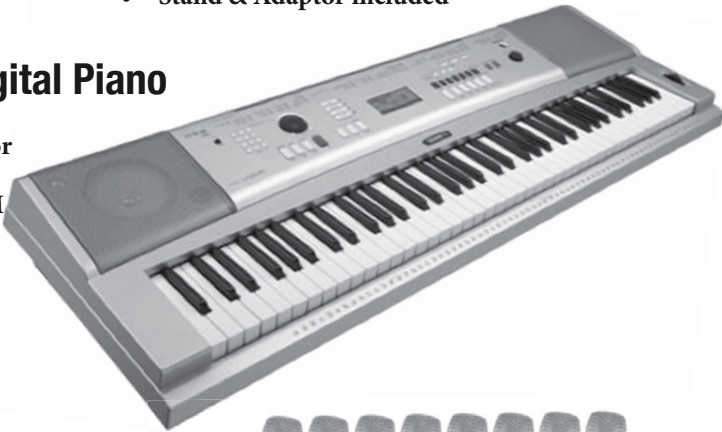

# Bengals stay winless, defense gets burned late by Packers

GREEN BAY, Wis. (AP) — The Cincinnati Bengals came so close to breaking through for a win.

Instead they found a new way to lose. The offense wasn’t entirely to blame.

A defense that had contained quarterback Aaron Rodgers and the Green Bay Packers’ potent offense in the first half fell apart late in a 27-24 loss in overtime on Sunday. “A disappointment is not finishing a football game now,” coach Marvin Lewis said. The Bengals are 0-3 for the first time since 2008.

Mason Crosby kicked the decisive 27-yard field goal with 6:26 left in overtime to complete the Packers’ comeback from a 21-7 halftime deficit. The game-winner was set up by Rodgers’ 72-yard pass to Geronimo Allison that came on a free play. Defensive end Michael Johnson was whistled for offside on third-and-10 from the Packers 21. Officials let the play continue and the two-time NFL MVP found Allison on about a 40-yard pass before the receiver beat a couple defenders for more yards. Rodgers also connected with Jordy Nelson for a 3-yard touchdown pass with 17 seconds left in regulation to tie the game at 24, completing a 12-play, 75-yard drive. Cornerback Dre Kilpatrick narrowly missed batting away the bullet thrown by the quarterback into the front right corner of the end zone.

“Far too many chunk plays against a good quarterback like that. That ended up being the difference in the football game,” Lewis said.

At least the offense showed signs of life, especially early in the game.

A.J. Green caught a 10-yard scoring pass on the game’s opening drive for Cincinnati’s first touchdown after two frustrating weeks for the offense. Bill Lazor made his debut as offensive coordinator for the fired Ken Zampese.

Andy Dalton was 21 of 27 for 212 yards and two scores for the Bengals. Dalton was targeting his best playmaker early, just like the star receiver had hoped following the Week 2 loss to Houston. Green caught 10 of 13 targets for 111 yards.

Then the Packers started getting to Dalton a little more in the second half. The Bengals’ backfield-by-committee rushing attack combined for 30 carries for 110 yards, with rookie Joe Mixon leading the way with 18 carries for 62 yards.

But a slip-up in the fourth quarter epitomized Cincinnati’s day.

The Bengals had driven from their own 9 to the Packers 27 with 4:31 left. But Mixon fell in the backfield on third-and-1, forcing Dalton to hold on to the ball for a 1-yard loss.

Randy Bullock followed with a 46-yard field goal to make it a 24-17 lead with 3:51 left in regulation.

Too much time for Rodgers. “I tried to get as much as I could, but it’s unfortunate in that situation the way we were moving the ball, the way we were driving down,” Dalton said. “And you get that first down and the game could be completely different.”

# Bills’ retooled secondary shines in 26-16 win over Broncos

ORCHARD PARK, N.Y. (AP) — Whatever concerns there were about the Buffalo Bills completely retooled secondary have yet to materialize on the field.

Three games into the season, the position group of newcomers — including rookie Tre’Davious White — stands second to none. They’ve yet to surrender a 260-yard passing outing or a touchdown passing performance in a 26-16 win over the Denver Broncos (2-1).

Safety Micah Hyde believes they can be even better.

“We made some mistakes today,” said Hyde, a fifth-year player who was the Bills’ prized free-agent off-season addition. “We gave up some big plays but at the same time, we will correct those and bounce back next week.” Whatever miscues there were, it didn’t affect the outcome in putting a blanket over a Trevor Siemian-led passing attack that features Emmanuel Sanders and Demaryius Thomas. Siemian finished 24 of 40 for 259 yards passing, and closed two of Denver’s final four possessions with interceptions.

Even the Broncos’ plan to test White by targeting receivers he was covering backfired in the end. Down 23-16 and facing first-and-10 at Buffalo’s 24, Siemian was under pressure when he threw a wobbling pass off his back foot intended for Bennie Fowler, which was easily picked off by White.

first half, Sufia fired a long one to the corner of the end zone. It was caught by Pulenu'u Fono for another Tafuna touchdown extending their lead to 24-7 heading into half time.

To open up the second half of play, Louis Malala Jr. steamed through Tafuna's defensive unit, as he punched in Samoana's second touchdown of the game, a 10-yard reception that came after a long run by David Mikaele at 8:57 into the third quarter.

Just when the Sharks thought they'd finally had things going, Pene Fa'avae of the Warriors watered their flame of hope out after he scored another touchdown for the Warriors, extending Tafuna's lead to 30-13.

With 1:36 remaining in the third, and Sufia leading Tafuna from Samoana's 22-yard line, THS Gaoa is sent up the middle for his second touchdown of the game.

Samoana's offensive unit, desperately trying to revive

themselves, are able to with just a minute remaining in the third, when Feala finds Louis Malala Jr. from the Warriors' 25-yard line – a pass reception that was good for Samoana's third touchdown of the game. Their two-point conversion in the hands of Pulefano Misitana was good enough to bring them back to trail the Warriors 21-36.

With 3:41 remaining in the ball game, and Sufia's passing rate passing the sixth star marker, he threads another laser through the heart of Samoana's defensive unit into the hands of Pene Fa'avae – a 15 yard pass reception for another Tafuna touchdown.

The Sharks thought the storm was over, but Sufia turned the heat up until the fat lady sang. With 5:20 remaining in the ball game, Sufia fired a 50-yard bomber to Fono for another Tafuna touchdown – their final touchdown of the game as the Warriors continue down the regular season with an unbeatable record after a 48-21

victory.

### JUNIOR VARSITY: SHARKS 46, WARRIORS 8

Samoana's offensive unit led by Junior 'Jam' Tanielu didn't take long to get on the board in their first meeting against Tafuna, after the opening kick-off of the game was returned by Kobe Lefiti all the way back to Tafuna's 5-yard line.

Junior Tanielu immediately turned to the sidelines to fire a screen receiver pass to Pito Amani for their first touchdown of the game.

Their two-point conversion was a play action pass out to Lefiti that secured the Sharks' early 8-point lead.

Early in the second quarter, with 9:25 remaining in the first half, Tanielu's passing performance starts to escalate to an unstoppable rhythm.

During Samoana's first down from midfield, Tanielu fired a bullet to Lefiti again, who caught the pass en-route and took it all the way down-field for a 55-yard touchdown reception.

The two-point conversion in the hands of Paul Fano was good enough to put them ahead 16-0.

At 3:49 remaining in the second, Samoana was still unfolding their 'air-attack', which caught the Warriors sleeping again during a second and goal situation, a quick slant pass from Tanielu to Avery Seu-manutafa extended the Sharks lead with another touchdown.

Just when the Sharks thought they had everything under control, Warriors quarterback Francisco Mauigoa managed to bomb one in the air to his brother Pa'apa'a Mauigoa for Tafuna's opening touchdown of the game from midfield – a 44-yard pass reception between the Mauigoas for six with just 1:43 remaining in the half.

The two-point conversion, a quarterback keeper by Mauigoa was good enough to bring them back to trail the Sharks 8-24.

At 3:51 in the third quarter, Samoana's 'air-attack' intensifies with Tanielu at the helm.

Sharks third down on Tafuna's 33-yard line, a quarterback keeper by Tanielu, extended Samoana's lead. Fano of Samoana with his third successful two-point conversion, put the Sharks ahead 32-8.

Not too long after that, with 4:39 remaining in the ball game, Tanielu fired a 47-yard touchdown pass to Samson Leulu for another Samoana touchdown.

Just when Tafuna's hopes of recovering were in sight, Samoana turned their lights out at the kick-off after the touchdown – when Samoana recovered their own kick-off on Tafuna's 22-yard line, and it was another shot towards the goal line for Tanielu and his Sharkies.

Samoana's first down inside Warrior territory, and Tanielu fires a long one to Jon-Jon Uga'itafa for another Samoana touchdown, as they extend their lead to 46-8 after the two-point conversion by Tanielu on a quarterback keep, to claim their first win of the season.

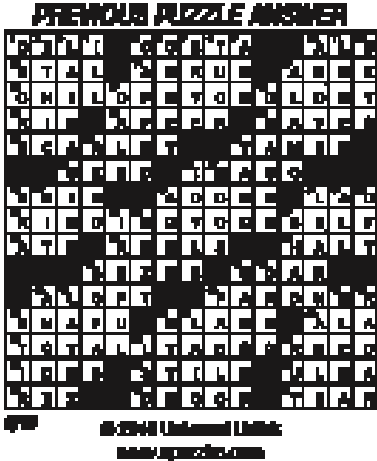
