No. 1 South Carolina reaches Final Four

STOCKTON, Calif. (AP) — Before they climbed the ladder to take their turn cutting the nets, Kaela Davis and A'ja Wilson started dancing. And dancing. The band blared inches away, and they danced some more.

A spectacular, spontaneous moment for South Carolina's two biggest stars: one headed to her first Final Four, and the other going back to chase

the school's first NCAA championship.

"It was just one of those in-the-moment things, having fun. We love our band," Davis said.

Moments before tipoff, Wilson pulled Bianca Cuevas-Moore into a quick embrace, then South Carolina's 6-foot-5 center began the night by winning the opening jump and the Gamecocks were on their

way to the Final Four, holding off Florida State 71-64 on Monday to win the Stockton Regional.

Most Outstanding Player Davis scored immediately off the tip and again with a timely left-handed drive with 1:42 to go on the way to 23 points. Wilson finished with 16 despite foul trouble and Allisha Gray acrobatically drove her way to 11 points for top-

seeded South Carolina (31-4). Dawn Staley's Gamecocks are back in the Final Four for the first time since 2015 determined to bring home a title.

And — wow! — South Carolina is hoops country for the moment. The men's program reached its first Final Four with a victory against Florida on Sunday that sent the women screaming in delight at Stockton Arena all the way across the country from the victory at Madison Square Garden.

"We'd also like to congratulate our men's basketball team, because we're coming to join you!" Staley told the crowd, then later pulled down the net and showed it off to both sides of the arena.

Leticia Romero cut the South Carolina lead to five on a driving jumper with 3:51 left. Then Brittany Brown's steal and layup at 3:25 made it 65-62, but the rally fizzled from there for the third-seeded Seminoles (28-7).

After the buzzer sounded, the Gamecocks hustled together for a team hug, and then danced at midcourt sporting fresh "CUT THE NET" T-shirts and Final Four hats.

Tyasha Harris added 16 points for South Carolina, which made things uncomfortable all game for Romero. The Spanish star had 16 points on 6-for-23 shooting as Florida State fell short once more of the program's first Final Four.

The Seminoles shot 36.6 percent (26 for 71).

"We just didn't hit shots. That was the big bottom line," coach Sue Semrau said. "You have to put the ball in the basket."

Davis, daughter of former NBA player Antonio Davis, delivered on both ends. She shot 10 for 15 and is headed to her Final Four debut on Friday against Stanford. She transferred from Georgia Tech for the chance to do something special.

"The end goal is just to get to the Final Four," she said. "It makes it 10 times better to say you want to do something and accomplish it."

Two power programs from the South that scrimmaged together the past two preseasons faced off way out West in Northern California, a rematch of South Carolina's six-point Elite Eight win against the Seminoles two years ago in Greensboro.

This one was plenty entertaining, too — from big plays to a nail-biting final few minutes.

BIG PICTURE

Florida State: Florida State forced 23 turnovers two days earlier and 18 more Monday. ... It again played strong perimeter defense with the Gamecocks going 3 for 10 on 3s after the Seminoles held Oregon State to 2 for 17 on 3-pointers. ... No women's team from Florida has reached the Final Four.

UConn, South Carolina, Miss State and Stanford in Final Four

BRIDGEPORT, Conn. (AP) — Geno Auriemma and the UConn Huskies have been on an unprecedented Final Four run, making it there 10 straight years.

This trip might have been the least expected of them.

With a trio of All-Americans lost to graduation, Auriemma had questions about his inexperienced group of Huskies. They answered every single one of them.

"They've owned the whole month of March, they weren't just along for the ride," Auriemma said. "It's theirs and that's a huge step. That's a big step, to go from riding in the backseat on a trip you're going to, to all of a sudden, you're in charge of driving the bus, you're responsible for getting us there."

Next up for the Huskies, who have won 111 consecutive games, is Mississippi State on Friday night in Dallas. Stanford will face South Carolina in the other national semifinal, giving the Southeastern Conference two teams in the Final Four for the first time since 2008.

That was the last season the conference won a championship. The Bulldogs are playing in their first Final Four after beating Baylor in the Oklahoma City Regional.

The Huskies routed Mississippi State by 60 points last season in the Sweet 16, but Auriemma was impressed with what he saw in the Bulldogs win over Baylor.

"That's not the same Mississippi State team we played last year here," the Hall of Fame coach said. "That's a whole different team. A lot of the same players, but that's a whole different team."

While the Bulldogs lack Final Four experience, they are led by a talented group of upperclassmen.

"For our seniors, they

believed in a vision when it wasn't real easy to believe. I'm really happy for them," said Mississippi State coach Vic Schaefer. "I know how hard they've worked. I know the blood, sweat and tears, the commitment they've put into this."

The Cardinal and coach Tara VanDerveer return to the national semifinals after a two-year hiatus. They too were perennial participants, making it there in six of seven seasons from 2008-2014.

"It's an amazing feeling to be back, and we're ready to play," Stanford senior Karlie Samuelson said.

If Stanford and UConn can win on Friday, it would create a matchup of the Samuelson sisters, with Katie Lou playing for the Huskies.

"I can't imagine anyone has ever done this before on separate teams," Katie Lou Samuelson said. "I think it was just meant to be that we would go to different places, so this would happen."

South Carolina rebounded after a disappointing exit from the NCAA Tournament last season to reach the Final Four for the second time in three years. The Gamecocks lost a heartbreaking game to Notre Dame in 2015, falling by one point to the Irish.

After surviving a second-round scare against Arizona State, the Gamecocks reached the Final Four with victories over Quinnipiac and Florida State. Dawn Staley's team has had to re-invent itself after losing senior center Alaina Coates to an ankle injury in the SEC Tournament.

The Gamecocks joined their men's program in the Final Four, becoming the 13th school to have both teams reach the national semifinals in the same season. Only UConn has won both titles in the same season, last doing it in 2014.

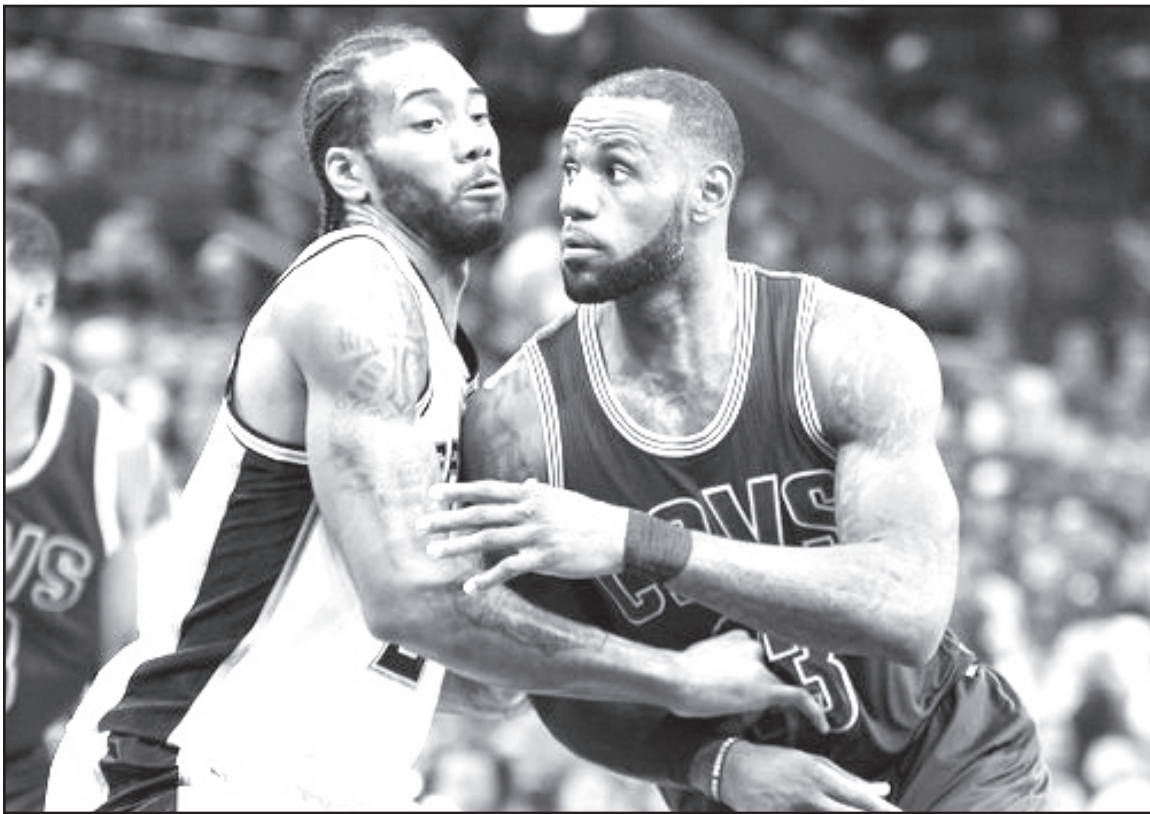

Collison leads Kings to 91-90 win over slumping Grizzlies

SACRAMENTO, Calif. (AP) — This was no feel-good road trip for the Memphis Grizzlies, who had another loss to contemplate on a long flight home.

Darren Collison scored 23 points and made two crucial free throws in the closing seconds to help the Sacramento Kings hand the slumping Grizzlies their fourth consecutive defeat, 91-90 on Monday night.

A veteran team hoping to play well down the stretch in preparation for the playoffs, the Grizzlies are struggling instead. They sit seventh in the Western Conference, 2 1/2 games behind sixth-place Oklahoma City, which roared back late to defeat Dallas on Monday.

The Grizzlies have lost nine of 13 overall and have eight games left in the regular season. “We’re frustrated, obvi-

ously. Each game (on the road trip) has been different. We’ve had good and bad games, even in the losses,” Mike Conley said. “Tonight we felt like we should have won. We really needed it.”

The Grizzlies played without leading rebounder and second-leading scorer Marc Gasol, who missed his second consecutive game with a strained left foot. He’s missed just five games this season after playing only 52 a year ago due to a broken right foot.

The victory was the second straight for the Kings, both over playoff-bound teams. Sacramento rallied from an 18-point deficit in the final five minutes to defeat the Los Angeles Clippers on Sunday.

“This was a game they needed. I know it’s tough without Marc, but this was

maybe our last stand for the year as far as you’re not going to see all our veterans play together for the rest of the season,” said Kings coach Dave Joerger, who spent the previous three seasons as Memphis’ head coach. “We just tried to wear them down and try to be the young, energetic team. We got two wins against two really good playoff teams.”

Conley had 22 points and nine assists for the Grizzlies. Zach Randolph added 17 points and 15 rebounds, and Brandon Wright scored 11.

Randolph hit two free throws with 32.9 seconds left, giving the Grizzlies a 90-89 lead. But then Collison made both free throws to put the Kings up by one with 5.7 seconds left. Randolph missed an open 3-pointer with a second left that would have won it for Memphis.

Leonard scores 25 as Spurs dismantle ailing Cavs, 103-74

SAN ANTONIO (AP) — The Cavaliers acknowledged having heavy legs, yet there is something far weightier on the minds of the defending NBA champions.

Cleveland is in the midst of one of its worst stretches this season and there is little time to fix it.

Kawhi Leonard scored 25 points and the San Antonio Spurs dismantled the ailing Cavs 103-74 on Monday night in a much-anticipated showdown that turned into a major letdown for Cleveland.

“The way we’ve been struggling, (the Spurs are) the last team that you want to play,” said LeBron James, who was fine after taking an elbow to the neck. “A well-oiled machine like this, they exploit everything that you’re not doing well at that point in time of the season and right now we’re not playing good basketball.”

James, who finished with 17 points, eight rebounds and eight assists in 29 minutes, said he will play Thursday at Chicago.

Cleveland (47-26) dropped its second in a row, set a season low for points and fell a half-game behind Boston (48-26) for the top seed in the Eastern Conference playoffs. The Cavaliers have nine games remaining, all against teams in the East, including a visit to Boston on April 5.

James said the standings “always matter,” but playing more consistently is far more important and he refused to

blame injuries or an arduous schedule for the team’s troubles.

“It matters more that we’re playing better basketball than where we’re at,” he said. “If that results in us having the No. 1 seed, the No. 2 seed, 3 or whatever the hell it is, we need to play better basketball. That’s what it comes down to.”

What Cleveland is seeking, the Spurs have already found.

San Antonio (57-16) is two games behind Golden State (59-14) for the league’s best record entering a home game against the Warriors on Wednesday.

The Spurs have won five straight and eight of 10 after sweeping the season series with the Cavaliers.

“It was a big game, but in the end, it’s just one game, and one win,” San Antonio guard Tony Parker said. “We’re trying to be consistent. We’re trying to play the same way every game. It was definitely surprising. Coming off a loss, I thought they would play with a lot more energy, but it can happen. It’s a long season. It’s just one game and I’m sure they’re going to bounce back and use this game as motivation.”

LaMarcus Aldridge and Pau Gasol added 14 points apiece for the Spurs.

San Antonio led by as many as 33 to the delight of the sold-out crowd, and the Spurs’ bench outscored the Cavaliers’ reserves 49-24.

“We did a good job coming out early and then keeping our foot on the pedal,” Leonard said.

“The look was good. It was just a little too hard,” Randolph said.

Buddy Hield had 14 points for the Kings, and Willie Cauley-Stein contributed 12 points and nine rebounds. Kosta Koufos fouled out late in the game and had 11 points.

The Kings are 5-12 since trading DeMarcus Cousins at the All-Star break.

“It’s always good when you win and the spirits are high in here. Losing gets old,” Cauley-Stein said. “So even for the old guys, the veterans, to get that win is special. We’re really locked in on defense and we’re starting to trust each other. It’s starting to show and it’s only going to get better.”

The Grizzlies went cold in the third quarter, missing 17 of 24 shots and getting outscored 23-19. They trailed 74-68 entering the fourth.

CAN MEMPHIS TURN IT AROUND?

Memphis has a favorable schedule in its final eight games. The Grizzlies have six home games, including the final four to conclude the regular season. Five of the games are against teams with losing records. But coach Dave Fizdale is frus-

trated, just like his players.

“The whole trip was a real disaster mentally for us,” he said. “It’s really frustrating for me right now as a coach because it’s not anything effort-wise. The last three games I thought we really competed our tail off.”

TIP-INS

Grizzlies: A veteran of 18 seasons, Vince Carter got a rare start. He had seven points in 28 minutes. ... Filling in for Gasol, Randolph made his fifth start of the season.

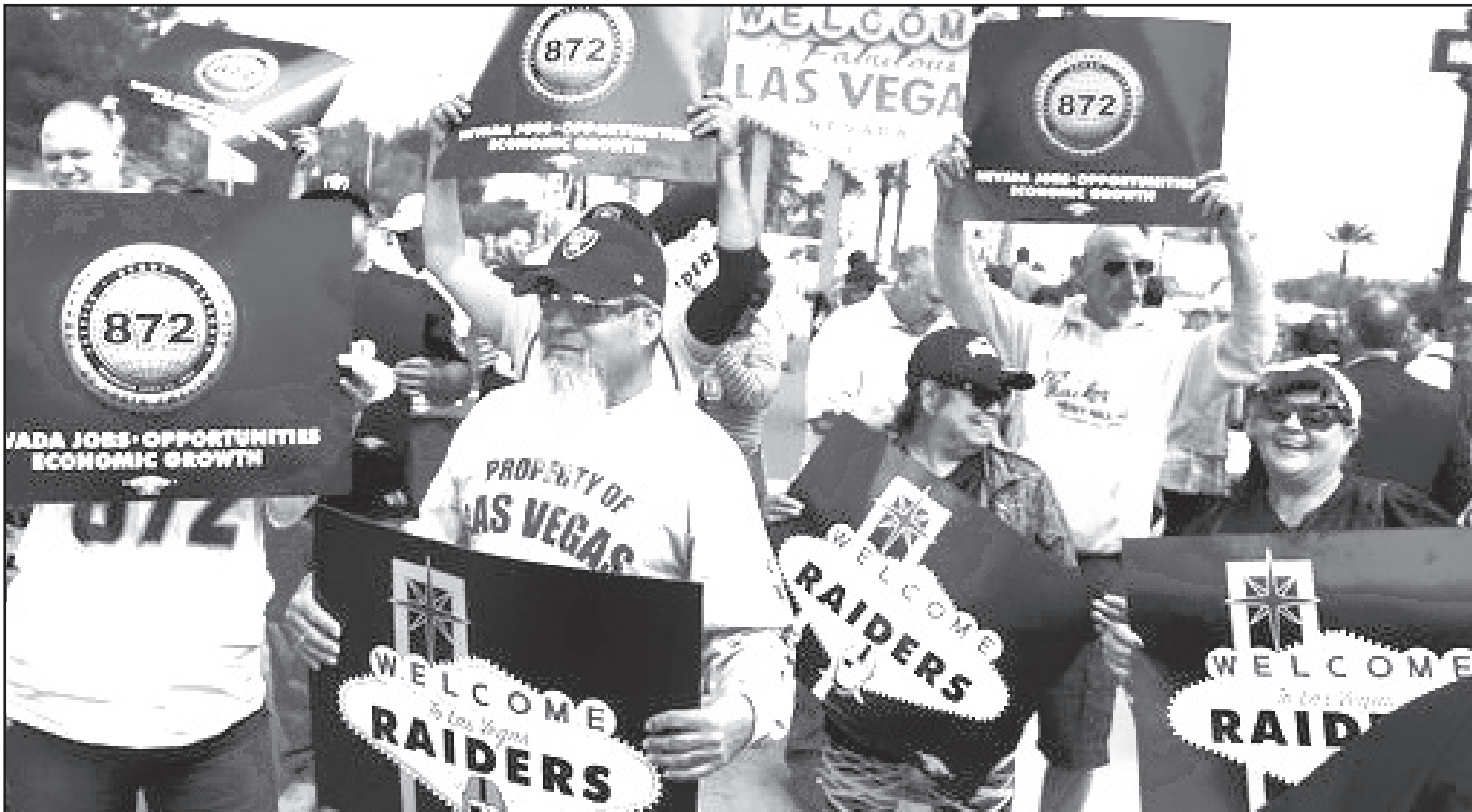

PHOENIX (AP) — Sometime in the not distant future, they will become the Las Vegas Raiders.

Until then, likely in 2020, Mark Davis' team belongs to Oakland. Well, sort of.

NFL owners approved the Raiders' move to Las Vegas 31-1 at the league meetings Monday. Miami was the lone dissenter. Davis insisted the club his father, Hall of Fame owner Al Davis, built into a champion — in Oakland and Los Angeles — should still be considered a part of the Bay Area community.

"I wouldn't use the term lame duck," Davis insisted. "We're still the Raiders and we represent Raider Nation."

"There will be disappointed fans, and it's important for me to talk to them to explain why and how."

As he does so, he also can address what is ahead for a team that, on the field, clearly is on the rise. Yet, questions abound how much support the Raiders can possibly retain in what is now a temporary home.

"My emotions are mixed," said coach Jack Del Rio, a Bay Area native. "While I'm sad for family and friends and fans in the Oakland area, I also recognize the tremendous opportunity going forward for our organization. That being said, my mission remains the same. To lead this team here and now. Players and coaches need to understand their defined roles. We all need to bring positive energy everyday as we focus on things that we can control."

What they can't control is community reaction in a place where devotion to the Raiders during their Oakland years — they spent 1982-94 in Los Angeles — has been admirable. Even during all the losing between their last Super Bowl appearance, for the 2002 season, and their next winning record, which came last year, the Black Hole gang has been dedicated.

Monthly Fuel Surcharge Notification

The American Samoa Power Authority is informing its customers about the monthly fuel surcharge rate, which is the direct cost of fuel to generate electricity. The charge for each kilowatt hour (kWh) comprises the "base rate" and the "fuel surcharge rate."

The base rate, which remains the same monthly for all electric customer classes, pays for ASPA's operating costs and for infrastructure upgrades needed to get power to your home and business.

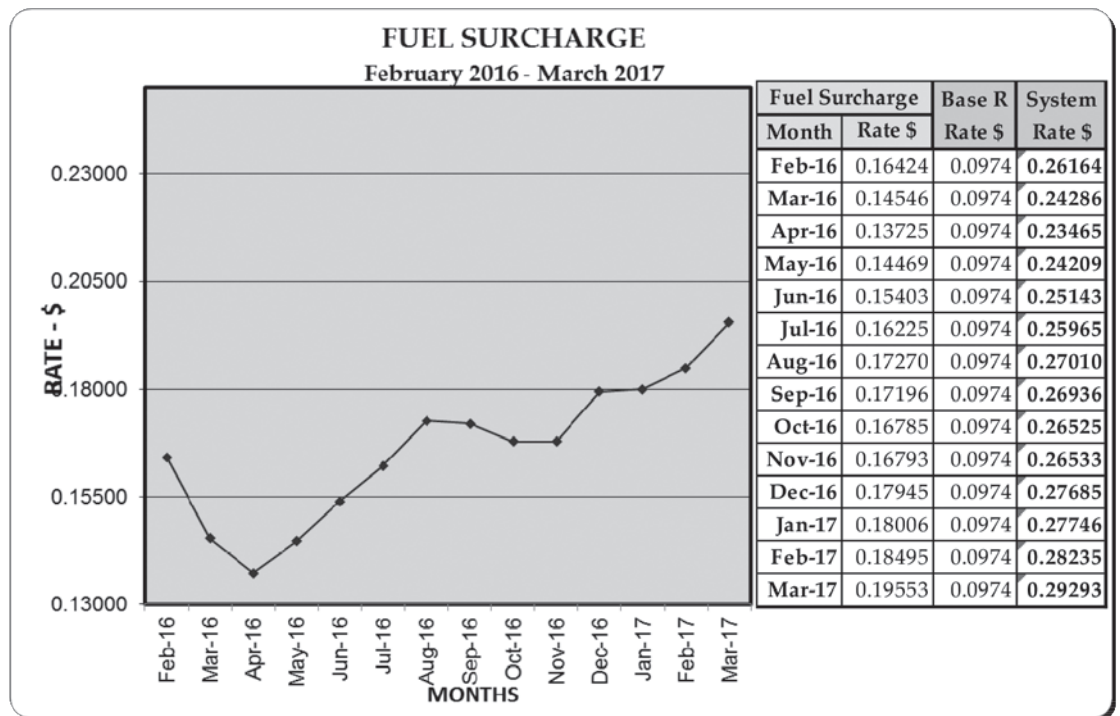
The fuel surcharge rate changes monthly due to fluctuating fuel costs. The fuel surcharge is

approximately 70%-75% of the total kWh price. This is considered a "pass-through" revenue because it goes directly to pay the local fuel suppliers for diesel fuel consumed at the five power plants in Tutuila, Manua and Aunu'u.

The fuel surcharge rate also includes the "Renewable Reduction" from electricity produced by the ASPA Photo Voltaic panels. The avoided fuel costs or fuel being saved from producing electricity through the Photo Voltaic panels, is passed on to customers as the "Renewable

Cavs sitting F Kyle Korver several games with foot injury

SAN ANTONIO (AP) — The Cavaliers plan to sit forward Kyle Korver for several games to see if rest and treatment helps his sore left foot.

Korver missed Monday night's loss to the San Antonio Spurs and will sit out Thursday in Chicago and Friday at home against Philadelphia before being re-evaluated, a team spokesman said. The shooting specialist missed seven games earlier this month with an inflamed tendon in his foot.

The injury has bothered him in the past, and typically Korver has bounced back after some time off. He's been slower to recover this time.

"I had soreness earlier," said Korver, who came back and played in three games after missing seven with the injury. "It's just not quite where it needs to be for me to play like I'm really being me. Everyone keeps saying we're going to play basketball for a long time — get it right for the playoffs."

Korver has had MRIs, which have not revealed structural damage. He's averaging 10.9 points and shooting 48 percent on 3-pointers since being acquired from Atlanta in a trade on Jan. 7.

This is the latest medical issue to hit the struggling NBA champions this season. Cavs guard Iman Shumpert also missed his second game with a sore right knee.

Cleveland players have missed 169 total games due to injury, illness or rest.

Cavaliers coach Tyronn Lue said he'll lean toward getting his team rested, even if it's at the expense of earning the No. 1 seed in the Eastern Conference playoffs.

"We have no choice," he said. "For me I just think health is the most important thing. You're always looking at the No. 1 seed. We lost one game I think in the playoffs last year; we also closed out every series on the road. To be a championship team, you've got to win on the road. For me if I had to choose one, health would be the biggest thing over anything else. We've just got to get healthy."

Cleveland's 103-74 loss at San Antonio on Monday night dropped the Cavs (47-26) a half-game behind Boston (48-26) for first place in the East.

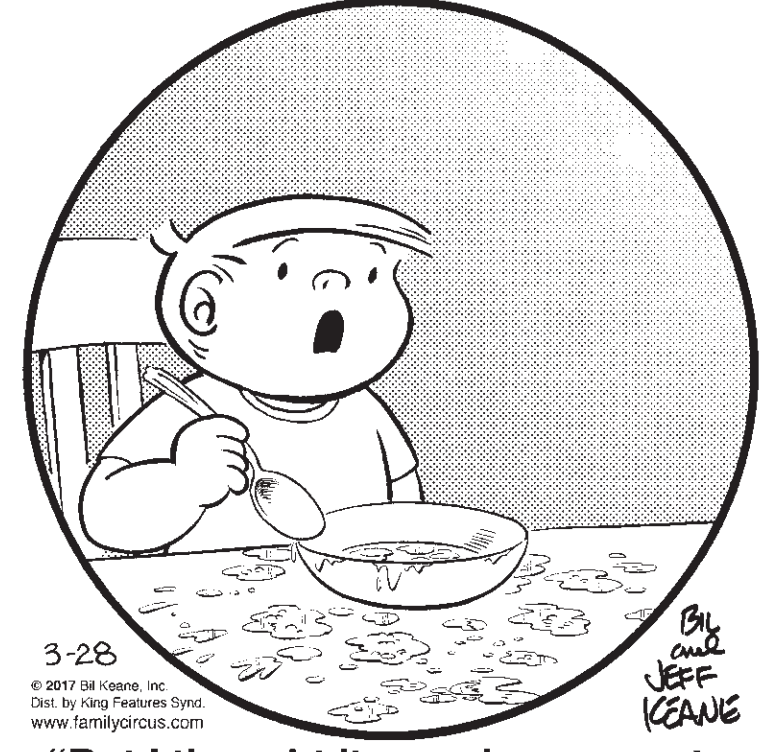
How do we handle this situation? Do we act like it's just like any other normal day? -- UNCOMFORTABLE AT WORK
