



In a compromise punishment handed down Tuesday, the IOC suspended the Russian Olympic committee for the steroid doping program that corrupted the 2014 Sochi Games yet held open an invitation for the shamed nation's clean athletes.




DEAR JAN: If the invitations that were extended were accepted by your mother and sister, and they are expected, they should attend.




